

# ILLINOIS LAW ENFORCEMENT PHLEBOTOMY PROGRAM (ILEPP)



- Created in 2018
- Sets standards for Officers to maintain qualification to draw blood
- Supported by statute and Administrative Code
- Immunity for Officers in 625 ILCS 5/11-500.1
- Need blood in DUI Cannabis cases per 625 ILCS 5/11-501(a)(7)
- Eliminates need for hospitals and is much quicker, thus conforming to the 2-hour requirement
- Forensic Phlebotomy offered at Richland Community College
- Dual Credit Course consisting of 4-week online course, 3 days of classroom instruction (labs) and a 7-day clinical placement
- Forensic Phlebotomy has already been successfully used in Macon County, Illinois since 2018.
- Currently 11 Law Enforcement Phlebotomists throughout the state.
- Cost of tuition is \$660.00 (not including book & travel/lodging)
